You can report any episode of this kind easily and anonymously to the reporting and information center **MIA** (Melde- und Informationsstelle Antiziganismus/Antigypsyism Reporting and Information Center).

MIA is a civil-society monitoring agency that systematically records and evaluates instances of antigypsyism in Germany. The agency aims to shed light on the manifestations and extent of antigypsyism in German society and to raise awareness of the problem. The intention is to illuminate the dark field of antigypsyist prejudice in Germany and to expand suitable measures to combat it. We cooperate with associations, consulting and anti-discrimination agencies and other civil-society organizations as well as government institutions. In addition, we offer qualification seminars on the topic.

WHAT CAN BE REPORTED?

- Antigypsyist incidents at the workplace, at school, in the housing market, in public spaces, etc.
- Insults, threats and hostilities motivated by antigypsyism
- Antigypsyist -related hate propaganda and fake news
- Extreme violence, physical or verbal attacks or property damage
- All expressions of antigypsyism!

WHO CAN REPORT?

- Those directly affected by antigypsyism
- People in their immediate circle, such as family members, friends or professionals who come into contact with antigypsyism in their work
- Witnesses of antigypsyist incidents
- Essentially anyone who comes into contact, directly or indirectly, with antigypsyism
